100th UK SOLDIER DIES IN IRAQ

After it was announced that the 100th British soldier had been killed in Iraq at the end of January, members of WPJF demonstrated at the Plas Coch roundabout and on Rhosddu Road, calling for all the dead to be remembered and for British troops to be withdrawn from Iraq. In a statement to the press, we said:

"These men and women are being sacrificed by Blair's government for its own purposes. We stand in solidarity with those parents of the dead soldiers and others who are demanding the return of all British troops from Iraq before any more lives are lost in this illegal war and occupation."
