The move towards the fair trading of clothes, crafts and food and drinks continues to gather momentum; though it can be difficult searching out fairly traded goods in the shops. *What's Wat* is a micro-business run by Christopher Spragg of Garden Village, Wrexham. Chris does not have a shop, but sells fairly traded clothes, foods, drinks, and crafts from his home in Wat's Dyke Way. He sells foods at Wrexham Farmers' Market on the third Friday of every month. He supplies foods and crafts on sale-or-return to local groups and churches. He put on a fashion show recently at William Aston Hall, with a lot of help from his friends! If they can be persuaded again, more shows will follow. Fed up of living in a warehouse, he now keeps stock at two stockrooms in Wrexham.

Chris welcomes contact by phone, email or letter, or visits by arrangement. You can view items without obligation, or ask for a sale-or-return box, to sell at an event, at home, or amongst your own group of friends. Alternatively, Chris can loan a catalogue of products.

Crafts, food and some clothes come from Traidcraft - catalogues from Chris or from Traidcraft on 0845 330 8901 for a regular quarterly issue. Then buy from the catalogue, or from Chris to save postage.

Food comes also from Suma, who supply fairly traded foods and also organic, vegetarian, vegan and gluten-free foods. Chris orders approximately monthly and will order for you by request, but he also keeps a fair amount in stock. Enquiries welcome.
